### 1. Part I, Chapter 1

In Section 1.3.3(a) ~ 1.3.3(b) , the surveying symbols **✘** and **✘** are missing. It should be:

In Section 1.4.1(d) ~ 14.4.1(f) the surveying symbol **✘** is missing. It should be:

| (d) Where multiple class notations for type of vessel are assigned, such individual notations are to be separated by a slash “/”, e.g.:<br><b>CR100 ✘ E Oil/Chemical Tanker</b>                                      |
| (e) Any suffix to a class notation is to be curly-bracketed and every two suffixes are to be separated by a semicolon “;”, e.g.:<br><b>CR100 ✘ E Bulk Carrier, BC-A{no MP; Holds 2, 4 and 6 may be empty}, .....</b> |
| (f) Every two sets of class notations are to be separated by a comma “,”, e.g.:<br><b>CR100 ✘ E Oil Tanker, CSR, ESP, .....</b><br><b>CMS(CAU) ✘ PCM, NAV.....</b>   |
